PLAYER/PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

We, Colchester Baseball & Softball League Inc., implemented the following Player/Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of players and parents in supporting youth sports. Players and parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to the child participating in our league.

Any player/parent guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following practice/game pending an incident review. CBSL reserves the right to administer and enforce suspensions of any length up to, and including, league expulsion. Repeat violations or multiple violations of the designated Code of Conduct may cause a multiple game suspension, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

Parent and player signatures acknowledge receipt, review and acceptance of the rules detailed below. A signed Player/Parent Code of Conduct applies to all immediate family members of the documented player listed below whether they have signed the document or not.

The vital elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: **Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Good Citizenship**. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

I, as parent/guardian, therefore agree:

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- 2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- 3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or others.
- 4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- 5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
- 6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
- 8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- 10. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- 11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- 12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- 15. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, alcohol or obscene language and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- 17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches.
- 18. I will not use profane, derogatory, threatening or demeaning language at any, and all, CBSL events.

I, as player, therefore agree:

- 19. I will demand a sports environment for myself and teammates that is free from drugs, tobacco, alcohol or obscene language and I will refrain from their use at all league events.
- 20. I will not use profane, derogatory, threatening or demeaning language at any, and all, CBSL events.
- 21. I will respect the coaches and officials and their authority during games and practices and will never question, discuss or confront them on the field. If a problem arises, I will speak to the coach at an agreed upon time and place.
