President report: Karen - The Town held a youth and adult sports president meeting, on the school permit side Michele is doing a new permit system online. Karen emailed Michele our latest Insurance Certificate. Town fields - Tiffany was given the list of things that CBSL needs to be addressed. Tiffany acknowledged she had it and sent it to Jim. Everything is waiting on the town budget to pass. Football brought up the stairs joining the upper and lower fields were washed out and need to be repaired.
