- Treasurer's report (Margo)
 - Monthly account read-out
 - Seth and Margo did study of what we should really be charging. Reg usually just pays to run the season (no profit).
 - Goal for this year is to set an operating budget for common line items.
 - Need monthly Treasurer reports to resume.
 - Bottom line: Are we happy where the budget is at?
 - We are \$6K in the hole from last year (operating costs).
 - HS: RHAM is charging way more than us for Minors Juniors.
 - SB: Portland is also charging more.
 - Let's slowly increase reg cost for older divisions...smaller cost increase for tee ball.
- Softball/Baseball Directors (Nick/John)
 - Fall ball updates
 - Bill trying to get some more games in for Majors.
 - HS: Juniors Only played 3 games…lots of rain-outs.
 - RHAM worked hard getting field ready at Bacon.
 - Will be doing some double headers.
 - South Windsor has lights. Try to get games with them.
 - Field/shed clean up / packing away
 - Need to check all bags of equipment for quality / quantity (sheds and goldilocks).
