    - Major -

- Discuss Cody Camp maintenance happenings
  - Cody camp looks great now
  - Expectations were different between the town and coaches
    - Town is challenged by the school workers being kicked out before times that were previously agreed (fridays 8 am - 11 am....turns into must leave by 10 am)
    - Actual field conditions inhibited the ability for the town to work the field
    - Town is so short handed it complicates the matter
