    - Softball our field conditions were terrible
      - Open balance on 2 softball girls
    - Minors BB matt to bullet out plan for how to make spring better (lessons learned from this year)
    - Majors BB -
      - 3 outstanding balances
      - 4 wins / 2 losses shortstop went on vacation during tournament (family dynamic issues)
      - Kids had a good time & want to keep playing
    - How did hosting go this year?
      - Out of town "Providing food" was the snack shack (leagues did not provide food except for our town) / inconsistent by division
      - Tipping umpires was inconsistent
      - Need to write thank yous for places that donated items
        - Majors has a list
    - Document a Tournament Philosophy for future years
  - Potential few games with Seth's contact (coaches): insurance, permits, details
    - Portland friendly games (post tournament)
    - Insured for the year
    - Permits: Town agreement RecPlex 3 fields as long as have a tournament team playing on the field; we will need to ask for an exception at the RecPlex
      - Determine the ask and Coordinate request
        - Action: Karen Belding to formally request field usage as requested for baseball (post tournament play & fall ball)
        - Need to coordinate with soccer (through summer)
