- Seth will meet with John Naples to get these carts picked up
- Storage Unit Project
 - Completed Kudos to John Naples. Thank you John!
 - The remaining locker is now cleaned out.
 - Money back for cost of storage unit for December- unsure if this will be reimbursed or not. John Naples will call to confirm that we are out of that locker. All keys are returned.
 - Remaining equipment and uniform Items will be offered at assessments. Whatever is left after assessments will be donated or disposed of.
- Uniform Updates
 - Two of the expected three bids have been provided.
 - These are single season bids for the uniforms.
 - Preliminary results are good.
 - Both bidders offered options that are within cost and of better quality than previous years.
 - We're going to push for the third bid between now and the January General Meeting.
 - Softball update on visors
 - Softball will continue to discuss this
- Merchandise
 - Hazen got information on improved sweatshirt order
 - The cost would be \$2810 for 100 sweatshirts for this order
 - 15 small, 25 medium, 30 large, 25 extra large, 5 double extra large (double xl is \$2 more)
 - \$28 is the cost/shirt for CBSL
 - \$35 will be the selling price/shirt
 - This company is the one who we used last year and had the bid from last year
 - Before placing an order, Hazen/Seth get two more bidders for the sweatshirts
- Bids for uniforms are also coming back with information about how their company can also do merchandise

- Merchandise will continue to be discussed as we choose a company for uniforms- many companies that offer uniforms are also providing information for cost of merchandise through their company. We will revisit this conversation.

 - Sponsorship collected as of today \$5,125.00
- Digital Raffle Next Year

 - Rally Up (Online option)
 - Multiple options for sports programs
 - Fees for using platform: 6.9% if you do not include the tips donation from those purchasing tickets
 - Additional feeds: credit card processing fee and a \$0.30 fee per transaction (taken off ticket price)
 - Link or QR code to buy tickets
 - Zeffy (Online option)
 - We get 100% of sale
 - Company will send email reminders
 - There will be a link on website
 - 100% free so they ask for a 17% donation (.85 on each \$5 ticket)
 - Person purchasing ticket can give the donation if they choose, but do not need to do the donation portion
 - Link or QR code to buy tickets
 - CT Rules for raffle:
 - Whatever your town puts into place
 - Colchester Rules:
 - Amy has already talked to the town
