  - Notes have been taken on specific slides in the presentation for further explanation. The notes below are a summary of those slides.
  - Notes for Coaching slide:
    - Coaching is an area to improve on and to help improve the league for kids
    - Tools for helping to get our coaching stronger and stronger
    - Dominate the Diamond- online training for all coaches at all levels, has a game plan for the entire season, practice plans, line ups, drills, etc.
      - There are videos with weekly updates
      - For references:
        - Cost for this program \$97/coach, there are also add ons for different drills and skills for \$84/coach
        - For up to 50 coaches we can get the same program for \$1900 for baseball and softball
      - This will give the coaches a game plan for the entire season
      - This would carry over from year to year as well
      - Everyone on our coaching team would be on the same page per division
      - Information for teaching each position as well
      - \*There are other free sites, but the videos are more introductory videos
    - Peer to peer training- having all coaches feel comfortable and that they have the help that they need.
    - Midseason review with each division coordinator- will help check in with the coaches in each division to see what each team needs, how the coaches can help
  - Parental Engagement Slide Notes:
    - Looking to promote and market CBSL
    - Getting more things out on our social media platforms
    - Want to get into highlight reporting (highlights from the game) get information and stats into the newspaper either in the Rivereast and/or social media
    - Game of the week- promoting the games each week
    - Gamechanger
      - Helpful in keeping stats for game

- Will need to push volunteering / game engagement so that someone can do this throughout the game
- \*Being used by many towns in our district
- Connecting with local college teams- softball side has used UCONN, also have a connection with the Mystic Schooners, have had talks with UNH as well
- Assistant coaches attending drafts
  - Positive for the league and the teams
- Messaging tournament team tryouts Minors, Majors, possibly Juniors will be announced around May 15.
  - There will be a tournament team put together.
  - The information will be shared ahead of time.
  - It is important to know that this is happening this summer and to give families the heads up.
- Player/Technical Skills Development Slide Notes
  - Wake and Rake- all hitting practice on sunday morning from (7-8 am)
  - Divisional practices- continue this with majors and minors
  - Add Sunday Morning pitching and catching practice (8-9 am)
  - There will be 3 divisional practices before seasons starts at Wide World
- Programming / Schedule Notes
  - Will be changes at district- looking to get more people at district boards
  - Work with district to schedule games on Tuesday/Thursday/Saturday (will allow for division practices, make up games, Saturday nights)
  - Memorial day- continue skills competition (6 skill competition, 3 sportsmanship award), clarification of Home Run Derby (12 year old)
  - Juniors' external tournament- take a little league team and play in other tournaments outside of the season- explore this possibility (will need to be researched)
  - May 15th announce tournament team, have both majors and minors ready
  - After May 15th have practices, out of district games, scrimmages to get ready for the tournament team
  - All Star selection play Memorial Day weekend game. Give the coaches selection criteria

  - Catchers equipment- continue to look at equipment that the catchers can use that fits them
  - Quality uniforms

#### Uniform Bids

- Seth and Hazen presented the uniform options
- Table was reviewed with prices and breakdown of each item
- Recommendation from Seth and Hazen- Vendor 2 (option 1 or 2 depending on if Softball wants visors)
  - Vendor 1- was \$800 more than we budgeted
  - Vendor 2- both options have dye sublimation jerseys, slightly better sock, pants with belt loops, belts, hats and visors
  - \$12 under budget
  - Vendor 2 Option 2 removes the visors
- Samples were available
- Cost, quality, and schedule can be met with both vendors
